Putting Victims First

Our mission is to provide information, timely notification, and support to victims of crime and other concerned individuals with respect, compassion and confidentiality.

How Do I Sign Up for Notification? A victim of crime must be certified by the Department of Criminal Justice Information Services (DCJIS) to receive information regarding an offender. We will help you register, please contact us for assistance.

Who can register for notification?

- A victim of the offender's crime
- A witness to the crime
- A family member of a victim who is deceased, incompetent, or a minor
- The parent or guardian of a victim or witness who is a minor or incompetent
- Concerned for your safety

What is notification?

We will provide notification by phone and mail when an offender:Transfers to a minimum security or pre-release facility

- Returns to higher security from a minimum or pre-release facility
- Receives a final release date
- Receives an emergency escorted release
- Escapes
